At last week's SSELP Heads Meeting we discussed The OU Reading School Programme that Teresa Cremin is inviting SSELP schools to participate in. We were all enthusiastic about the programme, and are, perhaps even more so, after Teresa's excellent workshop for SSELP schools last Friday.

A flier for both the primary and the KS3 programmes are attached. The programme begins in the autumn term 2023. Teresa Cremin is keen to work with the SSELP schools as a network. She is offering a reduced fee and SSELP will cover 50% of the cost for participating schools.
