As all schools are aware, Y4 SSEL pupils will be reading and studying the book 'When the Mountains Roared' by Jess Butterworth, during the Spring term. We know the copies of books have arrived safely in your schools and pupils should have received their personal copy.

We are fortunate that Jess Butterworth will be joining us at the Library Theatre, in Sheffield, on 19th May to present about her life as an author and to give some insight into her stories. All Y4 pupils are invited to join Jess on this date.

### **OU Schools Reading Programme 23/24 for Years 2-9**

Teresa Cremin has alerted SSELP to a great opportunity - *The Reading Schools Programme* - for securing developments and embedding change in reading.

It is a flagship yearlong online PD programme which helps schools transform and sustain their reading culture, targets disadvantaged and disengaged readers and as quoted by Teresa Cremin, "makes a difference." The programme has had terrific Ofsted feedback as well.

The Programme focuses on whole school change, with the English/Literacy lead at the helm of a 'Change Team' who drive the development work. Part of the programme is also a full day RfP conference, led by the OU team-online or f2f.
