### **Asthma Accredited Training**

SSELP has been working closely with health professionals over the past year, forging links and partnerships. We now have an opportunity for all SSELP schools to all become 'Accredited Asthma Friendly Schools' by NHS Sheffield Children's Hospital.

Emma Shepherd, Clinical Respiratory Nurse Specialist from SCH will be leading a free training session on **5th June at 8.45am – 10am at Acres Hill Primary School**. It is intended that one member of staff from each school will attend the training. Those that attend will receive a template policy/ asthma register/ parent letters/ leaflets and other useful information.

**Before attending** it is expected that the staff member will complete the online Tier 1 training, which takes about 30 minutes and results in a certificate of completion. The links to the training and registration instructions are in the attached leaflet.

**After attending** it is hoped the staff member will become the 'School Asthma Champion' and assist all staff members in school to complete the online Tier 1 training, in September 2024.

Emma is prepared and willing to offer ongoing support to SSELP schools. Asthma is a serious health condition which affects many children and families. Our aim is to become the first locality where all schools are Asthma Friendly accredited.

This is a lighter touch programme which offers 4 group sessions and mentor meetings for reading leads.
